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**::Admission to the B.A.- Honours and General / B.Sc.(Bio-Sciences) General
Courses::2020-21**

University Grants Commission has come up with the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) programmed where students can not only learn core subjects but also explore additional avenues of learning beyond the core subjects for holistic development of an individual. The proposed curriculum endeavours to empower the students and help them in their pursuit to achieve overall excellence. The implementation of CBCS will also facilitate benchmarking of courses in India with leading international academic practice. The CBCS curriculum has been envisaged to give flexibility to learners to learn subjects of their choice at their own pace.

In addition to dedicated focus on a discipline through core papers, whether an Honours or General programmed, the elective papers which will give students the freedom to choose the allied/ applied/ broad areas of their discipline and also the areas of other discipline of their interest have been added. The course will be evaluated by marking system along with the grading system.

The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), an internationally acknowledged system, have following aims: (i) to make the course curriculum learner centric, (ii) to encourage interdisciplinary without disturbing the domain centric knowledge, (iii) to promote mobility of the students and help in optimizing learning, (iv) to allow autonomy to the teachers to built in accountability , (v) continuous evaluation of students to help in optimizing learning, (vi)to introduce transparency in the evaluation systems, (vii) to improve employability of students.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 52 of Vidyasagar University Act 1981, the Vidyasagar University hereby makes the following Regulations for semesterised BA/BSc/B Com three years degree course under Choice Based Credit System, 2017-18 and 2018-19.

- ❖ The duration of the Programmed is Six (06) consecutive semesters of six months each i. e (03) three years and will start ordinarily in the month of July of each year. A candidate shall have to clear all the Semesters within consecutive five years from the academic year of his/her first admission to any college affiliated to Vidyasagar University failing which enrolment of the candidate shall stand cancelled.

❖ **Courses of Studies:**

1. There shall be three courses of studies leading to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Degree and each course shall be of six semester duration. First shall be termed as B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Honours Degree Course and second is B.A/B.Sc./B.Com. General Degree Course.
2. Six semesters will be in three years.
3. Odd semester (i.e. 1st, 3rd and 5th semester) is from July to December and even semester (i.e. 2nd, 4th and 6th semester) is from January to June.

❖ **Registration:**

- 1.Registration is mandatory for prosecuting studies. The registration for UG Degree programmed will be governed by the University Regulations relating to Registration.
2. A student shall have to submit Registration Form only once at the time of entry

to the UG Courses. He/She shall not be required to renew his /her registration at any subsequent stage. A candidate admitted for Honours/General degree course but not registered will not be allowed to sit for 1st Semester Examination.

❖ **Attendance**

1. A student attending at least 75% of the total number of classes held shall be allowed to sit for the concerned Semester Examination subject to the fulfilment of other conditions as laid down in the regulations. Such attendance will be calculated from the date of first appearance of the classes of the student.

Courses under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):

Under the design of "Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)" the curriculum has been moulded into **three tier** structure with following types of courses to be offered:

i. Core Course (CC): A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as core requirement, is termed as a Core Course. For Honours courses there will be 14 core courses and for General courses, there will be 12 core courses.

ii. Elective Course: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline /subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline /subject domain or nurtures the candidates proficiency/ skill is called elective Course.

iii. Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) course: Elective courses which may be offered by the main discipline / subjects of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective (DSE). For Honours and General Course 4 DSE courses are to be taken out of a pool given for the different semester courses. Further it may include an elective course designed to acquire special/advanced knowledge, such as supplement study /support study to a project work and a candidate can study such a course called dissertation /Project on his or her own choice with an advisory support by a teacher /faculty member.

iv. Generic Elective (GE) Course: An elective course which is chosen generally from a non-related discipline / subjects, with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective. A core course offered in a discipline /subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/ subject and vice-versa and as such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective. For Honours course 4(four) Generic Elective Courses are to be taken from the list of Generic Elective papers and for General courses (only for BA/B Com), 2(two) Generic Electives are to be taken from the list of Generic Elective Papers.

v. Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): The Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Course (SEC).

a. Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC): AECC elective courses are the courses which are based upon the contents lead to knowledge enhancement. They are i) English /MIL, ii) Environmental Studies. **These are mandatory for both Honours and General Courses.** These courses will generally be of 2 credits except environmental studies which is of 4 credits. AECC Core: AECC Core courses are meant for only General (BA/B Com) courses. These courses will generally be of 6 credit courses.

b. Skill Enhancement Course (SEC): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value based and/or skill - based knowledge and should contain both theory and lab/hands on training/ field work. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life skills in hands on mode so as to increase their employability. Minimum 2 for Honours and 4 for General courses are to be taken.

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❖ **How to apply for the CBCS Online Admission:**

1) Scan your photograph (less than 30 KB) and signature (less than 20 KB), Madhyamik Admit Card, HS Marksheet, HS Registration Certificate and Caste or PWD certificates as applicable and addhaar Card.

2) Register yourself by visiting the said website, get registration number / user name and pass word through SMS / email. Keep the information stored for future use.

***** Applicants must register their own Mobile No. and E-mail Id. All future information will be communicated through this Mobile No. and E-mail Id only.**

3) Login using registration number / username and password

4) Follow Step-1, Fill up details of personal information,

5) Follow Step-2, and Step-3 to enter the details of last exam passed and upload your scanned photograph and signature of the size mentioned above.

6) Follow Step-4, fill up the subjects for which you want to apply

7) Tick on the Agreement Box

8) Proceed for Online Payment, Click on the “Online Payment” and proceed accordingly.

***** Applicants must pay their Registration Fees through On-Line only.**

9) After final submission take the print out of the submitted form, sign in appropriate places.

10) Keep the printed/ hardcopy of the duly filled form and the necessary testimonials/ documents for producing them as and when necessary.

Political science (Alchiki medium) 8.Sanskrit, 9.Santali, 10.Sociology** provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

Y= marks obtained in the applied subject as Hons, If that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated in the table:

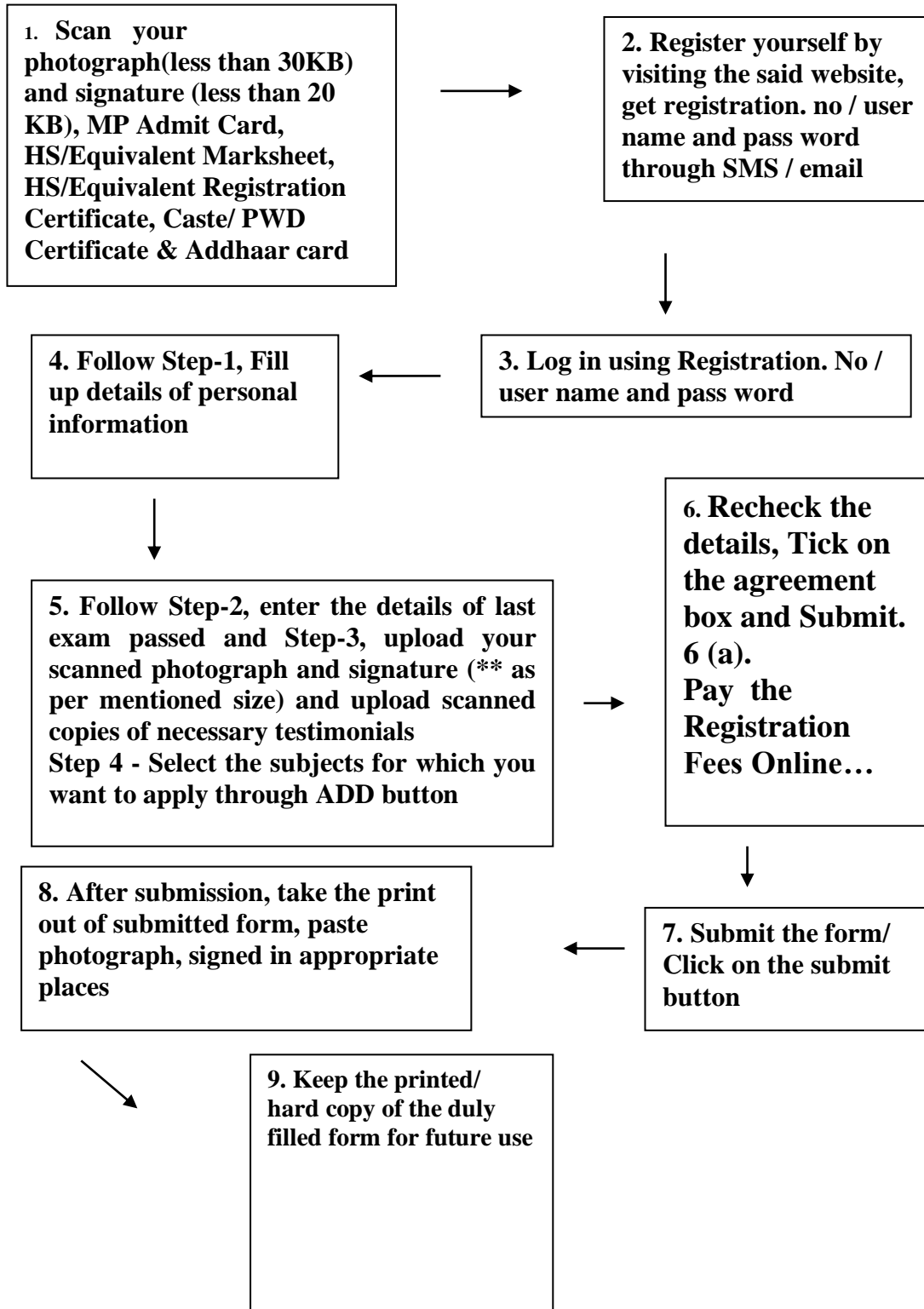

Z: for the applicants of the General Course, the merit point will be calculated counting the total marks of the **Best of Five Subjects** among the subjects studied excluding the marks of environmental studies / science.
